



Privacy Policy

We, Dynamic Port Agencies, will respect and obey the privacy of any person/data and we will make sure that any and all personal data provided to us will be treated confidentially in accordance with the GDPR (EU Decree 2016/679).

We take care of a proper security of our computer systems, offices and website in order to safeguard the privacy in accordance with article 32 GDPR.

The data will include the name, address, ID number, date and place of birth, email address, and if applicable phone number and car registration number.

The personal data received will be used for the performance of our agency duties for and on behalf of our principals, which will include the declaration of a ship with the relevant (port) authorities and any duties put on us in relation to the ISPS duties.

The data will not be shared with any third party unless with the explicit confirmation of the involved party/data object or in case this is necessary for the fulfilment of the duties under the agreement.

The data will be kept in accordance with any statutory obligation of Dynamic Port Agencies to keep data available. After the expiry of this obligation the data will either be returned or destroyed by us.

In case the data object does not provide us with the data itself, the party providing the data will not be unlawful and will not be detrimental to the data object's rights.

Dynamic Port Agencies will not be responsible for any damages as a consequence of the fact that the party providing the information will not act in accordance with the terms of the GDPR.

The party providing the information will in such case hold Dynamic Port Agencies harmless for any and all consequences as such, in any event the liability of Dynamic Port Agencies will be limited to the amount of the agency fee that gave rise to the claim.
